



HOW TO *Apply*

1 COME VISIT US

Join us for a tour or one of our in-person Open Houses this fall! Open Houses will take place on the mornings of **Friday, October 17** and **Friday, November 14**.

2 APPLY

Apply at scs.on.ca

- Applications will be accepted in the fall of the year prior to the desired year of entry.
- Applications for a place for September 2026 must be submitted by **Monday, December 1, 2025**.
- Late applications will be accepted based on available space; please contact the Admissions Office.



3 PROVIDE DOCUMENTATION

The following documents are required and can be uploaded to the parent portal throughout the fall. Applications are not complete until all documents have been submitted, with the exception of current year progress reports.

- A recent photograph of the applicant.
- The applicant's final reports from the previous three years and any reports available for the current year.
- A copy of the applicant's birth certificate or passport.
- Educational assessment(s) and I.E.P.(s), if applicable.
- The non-refundable application fee of \$250.

You will have continued access to your portal to be able to update and upload these documents.

4 INTERVIEW

Families will be given the opportunity to schedule a personal interview after we receive all the required documents, with the exception of current year progress reports.

- Formal interview preparation is not encouraged.
- Applicants for Grades 1-4 will be interviewed with their parents.
- Applicants for Grades 5-12 will begin with a one-on-one interview before parents are invited to join.
- Out-of-province applicants will be given the opportunity to have a virtual interview.
- In-person interviews also provide the opportunity to tour the School with a student ambassador.

5 ASSESSMENT

Applicants must complete an entrance assessment, which differs based on the applicant's entry grade.



GRADES 1-6

Applicants will be required to complete an assessment in early 2026. Applicants to **Grades 2-6** will write the assessment on **Saturday, January 10, 2026**. Applicants to **Grade 1** will write the assessment on a weekday morning in January or February of 2026. Assessments will cover grade level literacy and numeracy expectations, as well as a small group activity.



GRADES 7-12

Applicants to Grades 7-12 will be required to complete an in-person assessment, which will be held on the afternoon of **Tuesday, January 27, 2026**.

Out-of-province applicants who cannot attend the January in-person assessment will be required to write the SSAT or ISEE before **January 31, 2026**.

No additional preparation is required or recommended for these assessments, as they will be appropriate for the applicant's current grade.

OFFER NOTIFICATION AND ENROLMENT

Families will be notified of our decisions on **Friday, February 20, 2026**.

Enrolment contracts must be returned by **Tuesday, February 24, 2026**.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Financial Assistance is available to students in Grades 7-12. St. Clement's School is committed to enrolling exceptional students from diverse backgrounds, regardless of their families' financial situations.

St. Clement's School uses the services of Apple Financial as a third-party organization to assess the needs of families.
