

## St. Clement's School Entrance Merit Scholarships

St. Clement's School develops outstanding women who are intellectually curious, courageous and compassionate.

St. Clement's School is pleased to award one entrance scholarship each to a student entering Grade 7 and Grade 9. The non-renewable scholarships are awarded to students who demonstrate courage, compassion, and curiosity, and have shown examples of commitment to community. Each entrance scholarship is worth \$6,000 and will be applied toward the first year's school tuition.

## To apply for the St. Clement's Merit Scholarship:

Applicants to Grade 7 and 9 will have the option to indicate their interest in being considered for the Merit Scholarship on the SCS application form. Complete the Merit Scholarship application within the <u>Parent Portal</u> by completing the *Merit Scholarship References' Information and Video Link* form. All components of the application must be submitted by <u>Monday</u>, <u>December 1</u>, 2025.

## Requirements:

- 1) Video: record a video to answer the following questions and tell us more about yourself. The video should be between 2.5 5 minutes long. In your video:
  - a) Introduce yourself and tell us why you want to come to St. Clement's.
  - b) Tell us about a time when you have demonstrated courage, compassion, or curiosity.
  - c) When was a time when you have made a positive impact in your community? Provide details, including describing the community, what your role was, and how you believe you made a positive impact.
  - d) End with a "fun fact" about yourself, <u>or</u> briefly share a personal story or experience, <u>or</u> do a show & tell <u>or</u> any other ideas that showcase who you are!
  - e) Do not worry about how technologically savvy you are we want this video to be an opportunity for you to share who you are, so we will only be focused on learning about you! Please save your video in a Google Drive, ensure the sharing options allow outside viewers, and provide the link in the *Merit Scholarship References' Information and Video Link* form.
- 2) Two References: please provide us with the names and email addresses for:
  - a) A teacher from the current or previous school year.
  - b) An individual who has known you for two or more years. This person may not be an immediate family member.

We will reach out to these two individuals with a request for them to complete an online reference form in December.

The deadline for submitting Merit Scholarship applications is Monday, December 1, 2025.

Only shortlisted candidates will be contacted for a second round interview. We will contact those selected on Friday, January 16, 2026.
